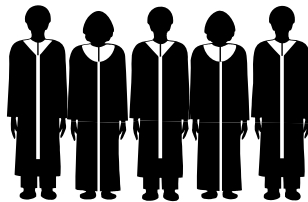

On several occasions it has combined with neighbouring choirs and the Royal Melbourne Philharmonic to present major works. In December 2008 the Chorale performed Handel's *Messiah* in Warragul and Morwell, and in October 2010 Verdi's *Requiem* at Warragul and Hawthorn. 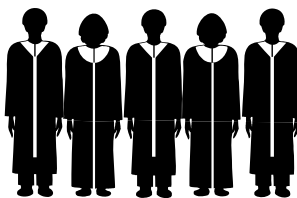
